**COMMENTS:** It appears that the biggest discrepancy in Ending Count versus Beginning Count has come from SW Washington Humane Society which underwent a computer program switch. All other shelters are working to finetune their statistics longterm to reconcile the difference. C and J are still not the same but have made large improvements compared to the previous year. It is assumed that some of the discrepancies come from kittens transferred to foster programs.
