For questions related to this data, please call (804) 521-1312. We will make definitions of each category of health classification available on our Web site. In studying this data, please note the following:

- Richmond Animal Care and Control and Hanover Animal Control are considered "within the community/coalition" because they also compile and share these statistics, and the county shelters of Henrico, Chesterfield and Goochland are considered "outside the community/ coalition" because for the calendar year 2009 they did not.
- If at any time during a pet's stay at a shelter, he is considered to be treatable or unhealthy/untreatable, that is the health classification he will receive when he is adopted (in accordance with the Asilomar Accords). This applies even if he is physically or behaviorally healthy when he leaves our care.
- Unhealthy/untreatable doesn't necessarily mean that a pet's life can't be saved and doesn't preclude our center from admitting him.
- The starting shelter count for 2009 does not match the ending shelter count for 2008 because a database discrepancy from 2008 was discovered and corrected in year 2009.
