COMMENTS: The ending numbers are not exact due to record keeping errors during leadership transition in the summer of 2009. Through socialization with volunteers and staff, and spay/neuter, our TM animals that have been adopted were very adoptable animals. Others were matched with the proper homes to provide the care and attention needed. Section C: Mesa County Animal Services and Montrose Animal Services; Section D: We took in a dog from Adams County; Section J: We transferred an u/u dog and 8 cats to MCAS, and 12 cats to Montrose Animal Services; Section K: We transferred 1 dog to Eagle County and 5 dogs to breed rescues located outside our coalition.
