**COMMENTS on euthanasia and 'died or lost in shelter care':**

**Jan:** We euthanized two dogs both for aggression to people. We lost one cat during her spay. We euthanized one cat with FIP.

**Feb:** We euthanized on cat due to an untreatable illness. Two cats died - one was found dead in her kennel - after necropsy - possible heart condition and the other lost during surgery.

**Mar:** Two dogs were euthanized because they were too aggressive to adopt out.

**Apr:** the two kittens that died were neonates. They failed to thrive. One cat was euthanized because he was very sick and was not treatable. One dog was euthanized due to behavior.

**May:** 2 dogs were euthanized b/c they were aggressive, 1 cat was euthanized b/c he was in liver failure, 2 kittens died b/c they were too young.

**Jun:** 3 cats were euthanized, all were unhealthy and untreatable, one was diagnosed with cancer, one had symptomatic Feline leukemia, and one was a kitten that crashed.

**Jul:** One dog was euthanized due to behavior, 1 cat was euthanized b/c it was in Liver failure. 4 kittens died while in foster care - fading kitten syndrom.

**Aug:** One cat was euthanized because she was diagnosed with FIP.

**Sep:** We euthanized 2 cats for health reasons. Two dogs were euthanized for behavior reasons. All four animals were not treatable.

**Oct:** We euthanized 7 cats who were all U/U cats.

**Nov:** We euthanized one dog due to behavior, 2 kittens because of health, one kitten was found died after her spay.

**Dec:** 2 dogs were euthanized due to untreatable aggression, 3 kittens died as bottle babies
